Sealed Tender Notice

Sealed tenders are invited in plain paper for disposal of Government Vehicle bearing Registration No. OR-05-G-7575 (Diesel Ambassador Nova Model), Inspector General of Registration, Board of Revenue, Odisha, Cuttack. The tender paper should be sent by Registered Post or put in the sealed tender box kept in the office latest by 2.00 P.M. on 30.09.2015.

The intending tenderers may inspect the vehicle during office hours on any working day in the office premises of Board of Revenue, Cuttack.

The tenderers are required to write the tender papers in their own handwriting without any over writing and sign with their full address.

Each tenderer is required to deposit earnest money of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees one thousand) only in shape of Bank Draft in favour of Section Officer, Registration Branch, Board of Revenue, Odisha, Cuttack payable at State Bank of India, Main Branch, Cuttack and submit the same with the tender papers. The unsuccessful tenders will get back their earnest money (Bank draft) on the date of opening of the sealed tender.

Sealed covers as well as the tender box will be opened in the presence of the tenderers or their authorised agents, who are required to be present in the office of the undersigned on 30.09.2015 at 3.00 P.M.

The highest tender will be generally accepted. The successful tender shall deposit 25% of the offered amount immediately after the sale is confirmed and the rest amount within seven days from the date of acceptance of the tender failing which the earnest money of 25% of the tendered value will be forfeited. The 25% of the bid amount and the earnest money deposited are subject to adjustment at the time of final payment of the tendered value.

The vehicle shall not be delivered to confirmed tender until he makes full payment of the tendered amount and comply all formalities (Tools, implements and spare parts shall not be delivered with the vehicle)

The vehicle shall be removed from the site within 07(seven) days from the date of depositing the full amount of tendered money. Custody and safeguard of the vehicle shall be the responsibility of the bidder after the bid is confirmed and no claim to complaint in this regard will be entertained.

On failure to remove the vehicle within the stipulated time as mentioned above, ground rent at the rate of one percent of the tendered amount shall be charged for each day till removal of the vehicle from the site.

If the ground rent so charged exceeds the sale price deposited, the tenderer shall cease to have any right on the vehicle and the amount deposited by him shall be adjusted towards ground rent and the vehicle shall become the absolute property of the Government and disposed of by fresh tender.
