No. 19822—IIE (G)-132/97-R.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the Proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa hereby makes the following rules to amend the Orissa District Revenue Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1983, namely:—

- 1. (1) The erules may be called the Orissa District Revenue Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service Amendment Rules, 1998.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Orissa Gazette,
- 2. In the Orissa District Revenue Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1983 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), for rule 4, the following shall be substituted, namely:—
- "4. (1) Recruitment to the posts in the cadre of Revenue Supervisors shall be made by promotion from amongst the Revenue Inspectors in accordance with rule 12 to the extent of 75 per cent of the vacancies arising in a year and by absorption of job contract employees of the Settlement/Consolidation Organisation to the extent of 25 per cent of the vacancies arising in a year on the basis of seniority subject to elimination of unfit.
- (2) Recruitment to the posts in the cadre of Revenue Inspectors shall be made by the following methods, namels:—
 - (a) by direct recruitment to the extent of 10 per cent of the vacancies arising in a year in accordance with rules 6 and 7;
 - (b) by Ebsorption of job contract employees of the Settlement/Consolidation Organisation to the extent of 40 per cent of vacancies arising in a year on the basis of seniority subject to elimination of unfit; and
 - (c) by promotion from the cadres of Amins and Collection Moharirs to the extent of 50 per cent of the vacancies arising in a year in accordance with rule 11:

Provided that if adequate number of candidates suitable for absorption of job contract employees of the Settlement/Consolidation Organisation and for promotion from the cadres of Amins and Collection Moharirs are not available in a particular year, the vacancies earmarked for absorption and promotion, as the case may be, shall be filled up by direct recruitment.

- (3) Recruitment to the posts in the cadres of Amins and Collection Moharirs shall be made by the following methods, namely:
 - (a) by direct recruitment to the extent of 10 per cent of the vacancies arising in a year in
 - (b) by absorption of job contract employees of the Settlement/Consolidation Organisation to the extent of 40 per cent of the vacancies arising in a year on the basis of seniority
 - (c) by promotion from amongst the Class IV employees of the Collectorate and subordinate offices under the administrative control of the Collector to the extent of 50 per cent of the vacancies arising in a year in accordance with rule 10;

Provided that if adequate number of candidates suitable for absorption of job contract employees of the Settlement/Consolidation Organisation and for promotion from amongst the Class IV employees of the Collectorate and sub ordinate offices under the administrative control of the Collector are not available in a particular year, the vacancies earmarked for absorpion and promotion as the case may be, shall be filled up by direct recruitment."

- (4) Absorption of job contract employees of the Settlement and Consolidation Organisation as aforesaid in the preceding sub-rules, in the vacant posts of a particular district shall be made from amongst such employees belonging to that district only in order of their seniority in the gradation list prepared districtwise.
 - (i) for clause (a), the following clause shall be substituted, namely :-
 - "(a) In case of persons appionted by promotion in pursuance of rules 10, 11 and 12 seniority inter se shall be determined basing on the position assigned to them in the selection list and in case of absorbed employees seniority inter se shall be determined as per the position in the selection list prepared for absorption and the absorbed employees shall enblock rank below the promotees of the year"; and
 - (ii) in clause (c), after the words "promotees" the words "and absorbed employees"
 - 4. In the said rules, in rule 22,—
 - (i) in clause (i), after the words "direct recruitment", the comma and word ",absorption"
 - (ii) for clause (ii), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:
- (ii) In direct recruitment, vacancies shall be reserved for women, ex-servicemen and candidates belonging to socially and educationally backward class and orthopaedically handicapped candidates if they have the ability for walking, cycling and writing, as per
- 5. In the said rules, after rule 25, the following rule with its marginal heading shall be added,
- 'Relaxation 26—Where the Government are of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do 9, they may by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provision of

No. 19828—IIE (G)-33/97-R.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa is pleased to make the following rule further to amend the Orissa District Revenue Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1983, namely:—

- 1. (i) This rule may be called the Orissa District Revenue Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) (Amendment) Rule, 1998.
 - (ii) It shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. In rule 7 of the Orissa District Revenue Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1983, for sub-rule (2), the following shall be substituted, namely:—
 - "3. In order to qualify in the test of physical fitness a candidate-
 - (a) if a male, must not be less than 160 centimetres (155 centimetres in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe) in height and 80 centimetres round the chest:
 - (b) if a woman, must not be less than 150 centimetres (145 centimetres in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe) in height; and
 - (e) must be knowing cycling and swimming. "
